**COURSE: COMBAT SHOTGUN OPERATOR ( CSO )**

This intense course will provide students with the necessary doctrine and skills to effectively fight with the defensive shotgun, one of the most misunderstood weapons in the self-defense battery. Course material includes practical marksmanship, ballistics, a street-proven gun handling methodology, continuity of fire, transitional shooting, shooting with movement, mental conditioning for combat, one hand manipulation and more. A training workbook will be provided to each student.

**EQUIPMENT:** In addition to a serviceable shotgun (pump or auto, 12 or 20 ga.), each student will need a pistol with a holster and a carrier system for spare ammunition (at least two spare magazines or speed loaders). A shotgun sling and an ammunition carrier system for it, a flashlight with a push-button switch and/or a weapon mounted light, and knee and elbow pads will be needed. Bring your issued carry wear or tactical gear if you use it, but bring the gear you are likely to fight in! Wrap-around eye protection and hearing protection are *mandatory* for all attendees.

**AMMUNITION:** 250 birdshot, 50 buckshot, 50 slug and 50 pistol are *minimum*.

**HOURS:** 08:00 to 17:00 each day. Night shoot on day 2 range and light permitting.

**FEE:** Tuition is \$525.00 (This does NOT include range use fees). Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis. A deposit of \$200 and your completed application and supporting paperwork will reserve your slot in the class. Please be sure of your schedule before applying.
