COURSE: CLOSE QUARTERS COMBAT CARBINE (CQCC)

This intense course will supplement the student's existing carbine skills by focusing on fighting in the typical environment of home, vehicle and street. Stress gun handling, continuity of fire, malfunction clearance, shooting with movement, weapon retention, mental conditioning for combat, and more will be addressed. This is not a competition oriented course but is focused on the use of the semi-automatic battle carbine for defensive purposes in the short range environment where time can be of the essence. It is equally suited to law enforcement and the private citizen. Prior completion of a recognized carbine course from Morrigan or other competent professional training is highly recommended, but not mandatory. Call if in doubt. *Document your previous training on your application form.*

EQUIPMENT: Each student will need to bring a serviceable carbine (AR15, Mini-14, AK, etc.) a carrier system for spare ammunition (at least three spare magazines) a flashlight with a push-button switch, and knee and elbow pads. Bring your tactical gear if you use it, but bring the gear you are likely to *fight* in! This is NOT competition oriented. Wrap-around eye protection and hearing protection are *mandatory* for all attendees. Your pistol, holster and at least one spare magazine or speed loader and 100 rds. will be needed for transition training.

AMMUNITION: 900 rounds of carbine ammo and 100 for pistol is a *minimum*.

HOURS: 08:00 to 17:00 each day.

FEE: Tuition is \$500. This does NOT include any local range use fees. A *non-refundable* (unless class cancels) deposit of \$200 with your completed application form, will reserve your slot. Enrollment is limited. Please be sure of your schedule before applying. Make checks to Morrigan Consulting & mail with application and all supporting documents to Morrigan's address below.
